- Monarda fistulosa (Wild Bergamot)

Groundcover. Choose up to three of the following species.
Antennaria plantaginifolia (pussytoes)
Fragaria virginiana (Wild Strawberry)
Anaphalis margaritacea (Pearly Everlasting)
Next, you'll select your Keystone plant species. Keystone species are important to include in our gardens. There are many keystone species, but goldenrods and asters are very important in our region.
The National Wildlife Federation describes keystone species importance here.
Keystone plants are natives that are essential to our ecosystems because they support 90% of the caterpillar species that enable our terrestrial birds to reproduce, as well as all of our specialist native bee species.
